## al-Qaeda in the Arabian Peninsula (AQAP)

On February 3, the Saudi government indicated that the Kingdom's police have arrested 28 militants suspected of trying to rebuild the al-Qaeda network in Saudi Arabia. The House of Saud has been waging a determined crackdown on militants since al-Qaeda's branch in the country, al-Qaeda in the Arabian Peninsula (AQAP), launched a wave of attacks in 2003. There have been no major attacks since the attempted assault against the Abqaiq oil facility in February 2006; however, 100's of suspected militants have been arrested since then by the Saudi government.
