

Twenty-four hour crisis intervention is offered to all survivors of sexual assault/abuse.

Advocates respond at the hospital and provide emotional support, clothing, information regarding procedures and options and follow-up support and referral. The advocate serves as a liaison between the victim, the police and ER personnel. Services are also available for victim's family and significant others. Advocates and staff also offer phone contact 24 hours a day for victims.

While crisis intervention may occur at the time the victim is receiving emergency medical care, it can also be months or even years later. It is whenever memories and feelings of the assault/abuse start to resurface and, is often accompanied by feelings of confusion, insecurity and panic.
