New Jersey Zinc/Mobil Chemical DePue, Illinois

The site is located in DePue (Bureau County), Illinois. This site was the location of a primary zinc smelter and other industrial operations since the early 1900's. It was placed on the National Priorities List in 1999. In 1995, the State of Illinois entered into an interim consent order with Horsehead Industries Inc., Mobil Oil Corporation (now ExxonMobil), and Viacom International to conduct a remedial investigation, remedial design and certain interim actions. Work completed thus far includes the construction of a water treatment plant, investigation of highly contaminated ditch sediments, partial closure of a phospho-gypsum stack, and the field work for phase 1 of the remedial investigation.
