ejection fraction, the proportion of the volume of blood in the ventricles at the end of [diastole](#) that is ejected during [systole](#); it is the [stroke volume](#) divided by the [end-diastolic volume](#), often expressed as a percentage. It is normally 65 ± 8 per cent; lower values indicate ventricular dysfunction.
