Definition of POSSESSION

- 1
 - a : the act of having or taking into control
 - b : control or occupancy of property without regard to ownership
 - c : **OWNERSHIP**
 - d : control of the ball or puck; *also* : an instance of having such control (as in football)
 - scored on their first two *possessions*
- 2 : something owned, occupied, or controlled : **PROPERTY**
- 3
 - a : domination by something (such as an evil spirit, a passion, or an idea)
 - b : a psychological state in which an individual's normal personality is replaced by another
 - c : **SELF-POSSESSION**
