It is also used to relieve nerve pain following [shingles](#) (a painful [rash](#) due to herpes zoster infection) in adults. Gabapentin is known as an anticonvulsant or antiepileptic drug. OTHER This section contains uses of this drug that are not listed in the approved professional labeling for the drug but that may be prescribed by your health care professional. Use this drug for a condition that is listed in this section only if it has been so prescribed by your health care professional. 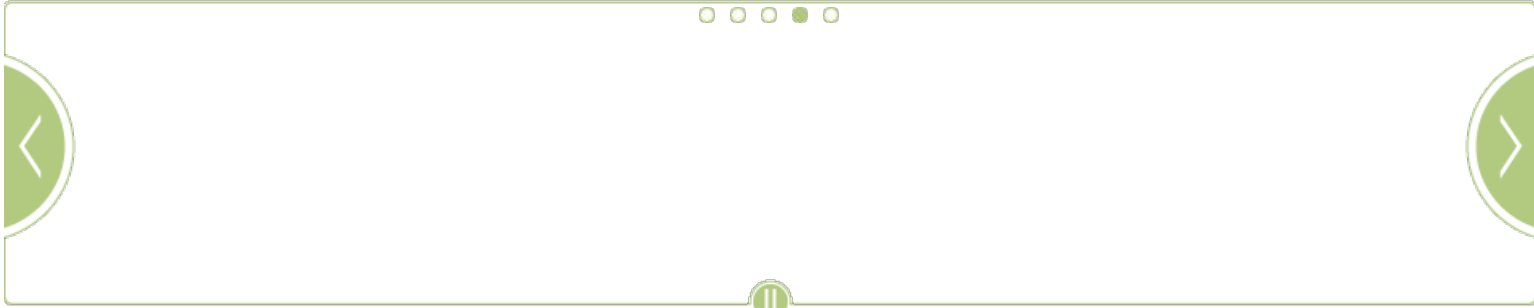
