Simple Definition of PRODUCT

Popularity: Top 40% of words

: something that is made or grown to be sold or used

: something that is the result of a process

: someone or something that is produced or influenced by a particular environment or experience

Examples: PRODUCT in a sentence 

Full Definition of PRODUCT

- 1 : the number or expression resulting from the multiplication together of two or more numbers or expressions
- 2 **a** (1) : something **produced**; *especially* : **COMMODITY** 1 (2) : something (as a service) that is marketed or sold as a commodity
 - b** : something resulting from or necessarily following from a set of conditions <a *product* of his environment>
- 3 : the amount, quantity, or total produced
- 4 : **CONJUNCTION** 5
