Simple Definition of SOLELY

Popularity: Top 40% of words

- : without anything or anyone else involved
- : only or just

Full Definition of SOLELY

- 1. 1: without another: singly < went solely on her way>
- 2. 2: to the exclusion of all else <done solely for money> See solely defined for English-language learners See solely defined for kids

Examples of SOLELY

- 1. His rank was based solely on merit.
- 2. You will be held solely responsible for any damage.
- 3. She did not write solely for money.
