

Effective August 4, 2019, Oshkosh Correctional Institution will be changing the days and length of visits. The visiting room will be closed on Fridays starting Friday, August 9th.

Visiting days and length of visits will be as follows:

DAY of WEEK	Length of Visit (hours)
Sunday	2
Monday	4
Tuesday	2
Wednesday	3
Thursday	2
Friday	Closed
Saturday	2
Holidays*	2

Two visits are allowed Monday - Friday and two visits on the weekend. A total of two visits is allowed on the weekend when a holiday is attached.

With this new schedule, the visiting week will change to Sunday - Saturday.

Purpose Statement

Institution Information

A new medium-security prison was first proposed in 1977, by the "Flad Report," a six-year plan commissioned by the Legislature, which designated "...the 300 bed medium security institution shall be the Oshkosh Correctional Institution (OSCI), located north of the city of Oshkosh at the site of the DOC Winnebago Correctional Farm." Construction was started in the fall of 1984, and OSCI was activated to receive immates in September of 1986. In order to make room for the many expansion projects to the institution, the Winnebago State Prison Farm was razed and relocated to Waupun.

Training Kitchen Information

The OSCI Training Kitchen operates in the institution visiting room; hours of operation vary. When open, inmates may purchase food items for their approved visitors from a restaurant-style menu.
