

Given the surge in positive cases at select sites and in response to the Attorney General Barr's direct immediately reviewing all inmates who have COVID-19 risk factors, as described by the CDC, to dete suitable for home confinement. Since the release of the <u>Attorney General's original memo</u> to the Bu 2020 instructing us to prioritize home confinement as an appropriate response to the COVID-19 par significantly increased its placement of offenders on home confinement.
