Treasury Offset Program

The Treasury Offset Program (TOP) is a centralized offset program which collects delinquent debts owed to federal agencies and states. In fiscal year 2018, TOP's successful state programs recovered more than \$2.9 billion in delinquent debts.


Are payments to you being reduced in order to pay a debt?

If you have received a delinquent debt notice or are missing money from your federal tax refund, paycheck, or federal benefits, you owe a debt. <u>Learn about your options here</u>.

How TOP Works

TOP matches people and businesses who owe past-due (delinquent) debts (for example, child support payments) with money that federal agencies are paying (for example, a tax refund). To the extent allowed by law, when a match happens, TOP withholds (offsets) money to pay the delinquent debt.


