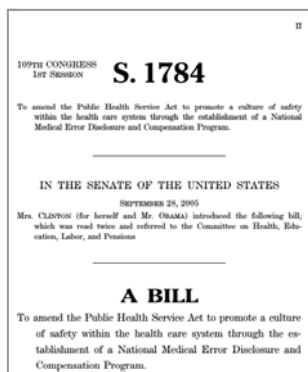

## S. 1784 (109th) was a bill in the United States Congress.



A bill must be passed by both the House and Senate in identical form and then be signed by the President to become law.

This bill was introduced in the 109<sup>th</sup> Congress, which met from Jan 4, 2005 to Dec 9, 2006. Legislation not enacted by the end of a Congress is cleared from the books.
