

Middle English requeste, from Anglo-French, from Vulgar Latin *requaesta, from feminine of requaestus, past participle of requaerere to require

Full Definition of REQUEST

- 1 : to make a request to or of < requested her to write a paper >
- 2 : to ask as a favor or privilege < requests to be excused>
- 3 obsolete: to ask (a person) to come or go to a thing or place
- 4 : to ask for < requested a brief delay>
 - re·quest·er or re·quest·or noun


