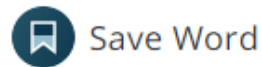

re·pair | \ ri-'per \

repaired; repairing; repairs

Definition of *repair* (Entry 1 of 4)

transitive verb

- a** : to restore by replacing a part or putting together what is torn or broken : FIX
// repair a shoe
b : to restore to a sound or healthy state : RENEW
// repair his strength
- : to make good : compensate for : REMEDY
// repair a gap in my reading

intransitive verb

: to make repairs

repair noun (1)

Definition of *repair* (Entry 2 of 4)

- a** : an instance or result of repairing
b : the act or process of repairing
c : the replacement of destroyed cells or tissues by new formations
- a** : relative condition with respect to soundness or need of repairing

b : the state of being in good or sound condition

repair verb (2)

repaired; repairing; repairs

Definition of *repair* (Entry 3 of 4)

intransitive verb

- 1 **a** : to betake oneself : GO
// repaired to the judge's chambers
b : to come together : RALLY
- 2 *obsolete* : RETURN

repair noun (2)

Definition of *repair* (Entry 4 of 4)

- 1 : the act of repairing : RESORT
- 2 : a popular gathering place
