- Are you 55 years of age or older?

\$20,971,372 million grant from the U.S. Department of Labor provided 90 percent of the funding for Goodwill's SCSEP programs in the program year 2018. Goodwill provided the remaining 10 percent through in-kind contributions worth \$2,330,152.44.

- Akron, OH – The Goodwill Industries of Akron, OH, Inc. received a subaward of \$232,450 and is contributing in-kind contributions valued at \$212,321.94 to cover the remaining 10 percent of operational costs.
- Sandusky, OH – Goodwill of Erie, Huron, Ottawa, Sandusky Counties, Inc. received a subaward of \$260,344 and is contributing in-kind contributions valued at \$30,177.74 to cover the remaining 10 percent of operational costs.
- South Bend, IN – Goodwill Industries of Michiana, Inc. received a subaward of \$948,396 and is contributing in-kind contributions valued at \$109,933.19 to cover the remaining 10 percent of operational costs.
- Louis, MO – MERS Missouri Goodwill Industries, Inc. received a subaward of \$2,064,156 and is contributing in-kind contributions valued at \$239,266.35 to cover the remaining 10 percent of operational costs.
