Mission Statement

The Milwaukee Gay Arts Center's (MGAC) primary purpose is to serve and promote the betterment of the Milwaukee LGBT community through providing a safe, secure and friendly environment for LGBT artists to express, display and perform LGBT relevant visual and performing arts as well as provide arts related educational opportunities.

History

Located in Milwaukee's Walker's Point neighborhood, MGAC opened in March 2005 with a cabaret entitled "Gay Broadway." In April of that year it was named "Featured Gallery" by the Historic Third Ward Association's Gallery Night for its inaugural art exhibition, Tapestries, which showcased panels of the AIDS Memorial Quilt and artwork by local LGBT artists.

Since then, MGAC has taken on unstoppable momentum. It has staged numerous theatrical productions including the notorious and infamous run of "Naked Boys Singing!" that was unlawfully closed by the Milwaukee Police Department Vice Squad, only to be reopened and played to appreciative audiences in 16
