Definition of PROCURE

procured; procuring

transitive verb

- 1 a : to get **possession** of : obtain by particular care and effort
b : to get and make available for promiscuous sexual intercourse

- 2 : **BRING ABOUT, ACHIEVE** • *procured* the prisoner's release

intransitive verb

: to procure women

—procurable \-'kyür-ə-bəl\ *adjective*
